

## Coronavirus Response Plan, Version 2.0

1. As the Government has now imposed restrictions on public indoor gatherings of more than 100 people, we will not be able to conduct our worship services until further notice.
2. We will record and publish a limited church service each week, which will be available to be viewed by 9:30am each Sunday. This will include prayer, a sermon and a benediction, but will not include music. Family and friends may be able to assist those who need help accessing the videos.
3. We encourage all members to view the recorded services each Sunday at 9:30am, so that we can maintain a sense of unity, community and consistency, despite not being physically together.
4. The evening services will be suspended until further notice. Members are encouraged to make use of other good online resources to assist with your worship and observance of the Lord's Day. Church Council has previously published a list of such resources that we commend to our members. Please email the office for another copy ([office@caseycrc.org.au](mailto:office@caseycrc.org.au)). We encourage members to be discerning and wise in what other resources they use.
5. All other ministries and events will be suspended until further notice. Some ministries will continue via electronic means.
6. Growth Groups are encouraged not to meet due to health risks, but are encouraged to "stay connected" by phone and electronically.
7. We ask members to make their offerings by way of electronic transfer (BSB: 633 000 Account number: 131198202), if possible, or to set aside your intended offerings to contribute once we meet again.
8. The calling process, and vote, for Pastor Dawie Van Vuuren will be postponed until after the coronavirus situation has resolved.
9. We will continue to pray and seek the Lord's wisdom and guidance.

To paraphrase Pastor Bernie Cane, chairman of the Recharge Conference:

*In the wider community's public perception, I believe we stand to bring the gospel into disrepute by proceeding with public gatherings. Non-essential gatherings are beginning to be perceived as a failure to love-our-neighbour (because of the impacts/risks on public health).*
